

Using a SWIFT Code for International Wires

To receive funds in US Dollars from any foreign country, follow the wire instructions below. International wires generally take up to 2 days; however, they may take as long as 10 days to be received.

The originator is required to provide their full address when sending the wire.

Beneficiary Account Number at First National Bank Alaska: (This should be the exact account number at First National Bank Alaska) <i>Corresponds to SWIFT field 59</i>	
Reference (optional): (Special instructions, invoice number, reference, etc.) <i>Corresponds to SWIFT field 70</i>	

* The foreign bank has the right to use its own correspondent network prior to the receipt of funds at First National Bank Alaska.
